This roof window is ideal if the home is in a noisy neighbourhood or facing the street as the Noise Block technology reduces noise (including rain) by 50% compared with standard windows. It also offers improved safety even in case of heavy impact on the pane.

- Two different low-e coatings containing silver layers on the panes.
- Laminated internal pane containing two layers of noise-reducing film
- Krypton gas filling
- Titanium dioxide coating
- Thicker external pane
- Improved noise-reducing cladding system


ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND LOWER BILLS

The triple-glazed roof windows mean lower energy bills for the homeowner and also improved U-value of both the glazing and the window itself.

The high pivot on this roof window allows access to roof space in case of emergency (M4A size and above). The higher fixing of the hinge means there is ample space under the sash for anyone to get a good view when looking out and then to climb out, if necessary. Perfect for roofs with a shallow pitch and where access to the roof is either legally required or desirable.

- Gas-spring assisted opening

SECURITY

Recommended: KAQ Secure

SHOULD YOU CHOOSE WOODEN OR UPVC WINDOW?

Wooden frames have a more traditional look and feel which may suit some properties better. Dakea only uses master wood that is FSC-certified Nordic pine selected for its excellent wood density and resistance to extreme weather conditions. This wood is durable and easy to maintain, but is still likely to need repainting about every five to seven years to keep the window looking its best. PVC windows give a white, clean and modern look and Dakea's PVC windows are reinforced with steel for extra durability. PVC is resistant to mould and won't need varnishing or repainting during its lifetime. Just cleaning with a damp cloth every so often will keep it looking great.
